An outstanding example of great New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, packed with fresh green notes such as gooseberry and fresh cut grass.
- Gran Tesoro Viura** 14.50  
Spain  
A fresh easily enjoyable white made from one of the top Co-operatives in Campo de Borja.
- La Font Francaise Picpoul De Pinet** 18.00  
France  
Made from the native Picpoul grape variety this wine is perfect with seafood, it also displays a slight palate cleansing spritz that enlivens the tongue.
- Domaine Du Mas Neuf Muscat** 19.00  
France  
A real winner! Bone dry with plenty of ripe stone fruit flavours on the palate and a delicious aromatic nose.
- Finca Flichman Reserve Chardonnay** 20.00  
Argentina  
This elegant and indulgent wine full of buttery notes with a creamy texture.
- La Joya Gran Reserva Viognier** 21.00  
Chile  
A real find! Rich and full bodied with many layers of complexity, honeyed and peach fruit notes on the palate.

- Paramus Do Rueda Verdejo** 23.00  
Spain  
From one of the finest white wine producing areas of Spain the complexity and body of this wine make it a great white for heavier dishes.
- Petirrojo Reserva Sauvignon Blanc** 15.50  
Chile  
A cracking Sauvignon Blanc from Chile's Colchagua Region, full of tropical fruit with fresh zingy acidity.
- Conto Vecchio Pinot Grigio** 16.50  
Italy  
Typical Pinot Grigio, Pear notes on the nose and palate and a supple refreshing acidity.
- Solar Viejo Rioja Blanco** 18.00  
Spain  
A stunning white from the famous Rioja region in Spain, great balance, really easy to drink.
- Monty's Hill Chardonnay** 16.50  
Australia  
Fresh easy going Chardonnay packed with rich tropical fruit flavours.
- Rongopai Marlborough Pinot Gris** 24.00  
New Zealand  
Well known in it's Pinot Grigio guise of which Pinot Gris is the same variety this wine draws it inspiration from the wines of Alsace, so it is rich, complex and slightly off-dry, a great wine.

- Gavi Di Gavi Docg, Fontanafredda** 33.00  
Italy  
An example of a first rate Gavi from the original and best vinyard area, hence the name Gavi di Gavi.
- Billi Billi Riesling** 25.00  
Australia  
Off dry but with great balancing acidity, this wine is a great match for spicy dishes.
- Chapel Down Bacchus** 27.00  
England  
England is now producing some excellent wines, this being no exception, try it you may be surprised!
- Laroche Chablis** 30.00  
France  
Classic Chablis, steely dry with mineral notes and fresh green apple flavours.
- Sancerre, Domaine Des Vieux Pruniers** 33.00  
France

- Katnook Founders Block Cabernet Sauvignon** 27.00  
Australia  
Packed with blackcurrant notes on the palate and nose underlaid with delicate herbal tones, this wine whilst being very fruit led is full of quality and elegance.
- Gran Tesoro Garnacha** 14.50  
Spain

- Torre Del Falasco Valpolicella Metodo Ripasso, Cantina Valpantena 2006** 28.00

The 'Baby Brother' to the world famous Amarone style of Valpolicella, this Ripasso style takes some of that characteristic richness and combines it with an uplifting acidic freshness.

- Brouilly, Louis Tete** 30.00  
France  
Fantastic wine made from the elusive Gamay grape, rarely seen outside of Beaujolais as it needs the perfect conditions to thrive, the volcanic soils of this Beaujolais Cru provide that certain something that sets this wine apart from the crowd.
- Q Clay** 33.00  
Chile  
This 'Icon' wine from Chile is a great example of the high quality wines the country is now producing, rich and indulgent with hints of chocolate and dark fruit, a great alternative to Bordeaux.
- Antoine Moueix Grand Cru St. Emillion** 33.00  
France  
A classic Bordeaux Grand Cru from the famous right bank where Merlot plays the dominant role and Cabernet Sauvignon adds backbone and structure.
- Petirrojo Reserva Merlot** 15.50  
Chile  
Ripe plummy Merlot with spicy aftertones from one of Chiles best family run producers.


